- Students must maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- A total of 45 upper division (3000/4000 level) credits are required.
- 30 total credits must be completed in residency at UC Denver.
- 27 credits of all FA credits (at any level) must be taken at UC Denver.
- 25 credits of total FA courses must be upper division (3000/4000 level).
- Students must check official catalog course description and abide by all published pre- and co-reqs, including minimum grades.
- CAM policy states that students who miss the first two class sessions of any CAM course could be administratively dropped. Likewise, students will not be permitted to add any CAM course if they have missed the first two class sessions.
