### **The John & Rose Berg Memorial Scholarship for Freshmen**

### **College of Arts & Media Transfer Student Scholarship**

**Marriott.** Five \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded in each of the following disciplines: Music, Theatre, Visual Arts, and Film Production (one per discipline area). All scholarships are based on the following prioritized criterion: 1) artistic ability; 2) academic performance; and 3) financial need. The maximum scholarship may not exceed full resident tuition and fees for the enrolled credit hours plus 10% of that amount for a book allowance. Scholarship is awarded half in Fall and half in Spring.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- **Marriott.** Must be a graduate from a public school high school in Denver, Adams, Jefferson, Douglas, or Arapahoe County. Preference is given to students from Denver School of the Arts.
- **Berg.** Must be a graduate from a public school high school within Colorado.
- **Transfer Students.** Earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 in previous college coursework if having completed 30 or more semester hours. Earned a minimum of a 3.25 High School GPA if transferring with 29 or fewer semester hours.
- Classified as a Colorado Resident for tuition assessment purposes.
- Accepted in the University of Colorado at Denver and the College of Arts and Media.
- Have a declared major within the College of Arts & Media (Music; Theatre, Film, & Video Production; Visual Arts).

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

- Be enrolled for at least 6 semester credits for the period of the scholarship.
- Maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher during the period of the scholarship.
- May be asked to complete a designated project within the student's discipline, which may involve the department, its students or the Denver community.
- May be asked to attend an event to meet with the donors.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

- Complete & submit a CAM Scholarship Application Coversheet.
- Include a resume listing specific performances, showings, workshops, and class work you have done in your discipline.
- Write a one to two page essay, responding to the following prompt: "The CAM mission is help students see themselves working in the arts and culture industries after they graduate—and to have this vision from their first day on campus as a CAM major. Describe how you see yourself working in the arts after you graduate, and how do you see the program you are enrolled in helping you to achieve this goal."

**DEADLINE:** April 1<sup>st</sup> for Fall award  
December 1<sup>st</sup> for Spring award (Transfer Student Scholarship only)
